This is a new service to replace the No 94 beyond Wickham. If you live in Wickham, Shedfield, Shirrell Heath or Swanmore and have difficulty getting to the bus stop to use the regular services, take advantage of the Meon Valley Minibus for journeys to and from Wickham and Fareham. The service collects you from home and stops at Wickham Square, Sainsbury's at Broadcut and Fareham centre.
