The Square will be closed between 10am on Sunday 20th May until 10am on Tuesday 22nd May.

Winchester Road will be closed between Buddens Road and the Shell Garage roundabout between 5am and 7pm on Monday 21st May.

Diversions and access for local residents will be in place as in past years.

Speed limit changes for School Road
