Housing in return for water meadows – landowner offer at Knowle

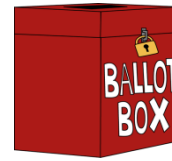

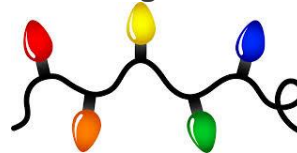


Could you become a local councillor?
